





Call for Nominations: Humboldt Award for Excellence in Teaching 2022

Topic

This year's Award for Excellence in Teaching is looking for teachers and projects that have succeeded in an outstanding way in actively involving students in **collaborative concepts**. In particular, we are looking for teachers, teaching-learning concepts and institutions that have supported students to work and discuss together and have succeeded in involving students in the development of a joint project.

Nomination

Any event in which students construct knowledge and produce an outcome together is eligible for nomination. These could be, for example:

- Events that allow students to work in teams or groups to complete a common task.
- approaches in which students work with external partners, e.g. international institutions
- Concepts of participatory teaching development, in which students work with teachers to develop teaching elements for future semesters.
- Concepts of social engagement, in which students work together with nonuniversity partners in the application area to find solutions
- Cross-institutional concepts that enable students to work together across subjects to achieve a result

Can you think of courses from the winter semester 21/22, the summer semester 2022 or the current winter semester 2022/23 in which collaborative and cooperative teaching was implemented particularly successfully? Then nominate them by **05 February 2023** for the Humboldt Award for Excellence in Teaching 2022!
